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## Choosing a PDWS Role

NOTE: Determine Access Role based on user needs, not title

Role at the Program	Role to be Assigned in the PDWS
Program Director	Program Super User
Associate Program Director	Alternate Program Super User
Program Coordinator	Alternate Program Super User or Program Coordinator The Program Coordinator role is able to perform all PDWS functions except modify "Data Filters." In order to modify the program's "Data Filters," the coordinator must be given the Alternate Program Super User role.
	<b>Reviewer_Interviewer</b> - allows users to see a subset of applicants assigned to them and all documentation, including transcripts. Users are able to enter/edit scores and comments.
Faculty Reviewing or	<b>Reviewer_Interviewer Read-Only</b> - allows users to see a subset of applicants assigned to them and all documentation, including transcripts. This is a read only role so users are not able to edit.
Interviewing Applications	Reviewer_Interviewer Limited Access - allows users to see a subset of applicants assigned to them, and only the Personal Statement, LORs, MSPE, and CV.
	Note: Users with any Reviewer_Interviewer role must be assigned or scheduled with an applicant to view their application.
